## OBJECTIVES

### 1- QUALIFIED INDIVIDUALS, STRONG SOCIETY

- ▶ To expand social welfare with a sustainable and inclusive development approach
- ▶ To enhance qualifications and competence of individuals and society
- ▶ To create a healthy, secure and a high standard social environment
- ▶ To ensure human rights and individual freedoms through a fair and efficiently functioning legal system
- ▶ To increase the quality and the accessibility of public services
- ▶ To provide accessible, qualified, cost-effective and sustainable health services supported by data and evidence-based policies
- ▶ To maintain quality-focused transformation in the education system which is based on equal opportunities
- ▶ To develop a more autonomous higher education system which is more sensitive to the needs of the society and the economy, interacts with its national and international stakeholders, and enables transfer of knowledge into benefits
- ▶ To increase the gross schooling rate to 70 percent in pre-school education and to 94 percent in higher education
- ▶ To ensure that the legal system has a steering role in realization of growth and development
- ▶ To improve income distribution and decrease to zero the number of population having a daily living expenditure of less than 4.30 dollars
- ▶ To strengthen solidarity and social unity based on national culture and common values
- ▶ To reduce the informal employment rate from 37.5 percent to 30 percent
- ▶ To transform the social security system into a fair, financially sustainable structure of high quality which covers the entire population
- ▶ To increase quality of life by preserving our dynamic population structure

## OBJECTIVES

### 2- INNOVATIVE PRODUCTION, STABLE AND HIGH GROWTH

- ▶ To take our place among high-income group countries
- ▶ To accelerate the accumulation of capital and industrialization process
- ▶ To use the country's resources in productive areas
- ▶ To reduce the current account deficit to a reasonable permanent level
- ▶ To increase innovation production capacity, ensure transformation of the productive structure by integrating innovations
- ▶ To reach 5.5 percent average annual growth rate
- ▶ To create a total of 4 million new jobs
- ▶ To ensure that the Istanbul International Financial Center is among the top twenty-five in the global financial centers index
- ▶ To decrease gradually public sector borrowing requirement to 0.5 percent of GDP
- ▶ To increase the rate of public sector fixed capital investments to 4.8 percent of GDP, while increasing the rate of private investment to 19.3 percent of GDP
- ▶ To increase the rate of R & D expenditures to 1.8 percent of GDP
- ▶ To use information and communication technologies widely and efficiently to accelerate the transformation to an information society
- ▶ To increase manufacturing industry exports to 257 billion dollars and the share of medium-high and high technology sectors in exports
- ▶ To increase the consolidated land by nearly double to 8 million hectares
- ▶ To increase the irrigation area for use from 2.9 million hectares to 3.8 million hectares
- ▶ To increase the Installed Power of Electricity from 58,000 MW to 78,000 MW
- ▶ To enable Turkey to become a regional hub in logistics and to substantially put port capacities into use
- ▶ To increase the divided road network, including the motorways, to 30,000 km and high-speed train lines to 2,500 km
- ▶ To increase the number of foreign visitors to 42 million people and tourism income to 45 billion dollars

## OBJECTIVES

### 3- LIVABLE PLACES, SUSTAINABLE ENVIRONMENT

- ▶ To expand welfare in a more balanced way by reducing regional development disparities
- ▶ To approximate the minimum level of wealth in rural areas to country averages
- ▶ To construct disaster-resistant living places by supporting economic development and based on cultural values
- ▶ To ensure all segments of the population have access to adequate, healthier, and safer housing
- ▶ To improve access to healthy and safe potable-usable water in the cities
- ▶ To increase the ratio of municipal population provided with wastewater services to 80 percent and the ratio of municipal population with sanitary landfills to 85 percent
- ▶ To extend environment friendly practices and ensure sustainability in the use of natural resources

### 4- INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION FOR DEVELOPMENT

- ▶ To benefit more from international dynamics in the development process and share our experiences with other countries
- ▶ To pursue an effective development cooperation policy which realizes international peace, prosperity, and stability
- ▶ To play a more active role in determination of a global development agenda
